SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS

Public Comment Period

Dr. Levey called for public comments. There were no public comments.

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of the Minutes of the July 18, 2023, Board of Supervisors' Meeting

The Board reviewed the minutes of the July 18, 2023, Board of Supervisors' Meeting.

On motion by Mr. Czapka, seconded by Ms. Salvo, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Boggy Creek Improvement District approved the Minutes of the July 18, 2023, Board of Supervisors' Meeting.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Resolution 2023-09, Approving an Annual Meeting Schedule for Fiscal Year 2024 Ms. Walden stated District staff would like to move the Board of Supervisors' Meetings to the Tavistock offices as there will be no cost for holding the meetings at this location. The meetings will be held on the third Tuesday of each month at 3:00 p.m. at Tavistock except for November, December and March, which would be the second Tuesday. Additionally, District staff noticed with the Construction Committee schedule that some of the days were after the Board Meetings, so the District will keep all of the dates for the Constructions Committee on the 2nd Thursday of the month at 3:30 p.m. at the Tavistock offices, except for December and March, which will move up to the first Tuesday.

On motion by Ms. Salvo, seconded by Mr. Czapka, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Boggy Creek Improvement District approved Resolution 2023-09, Approving an Annual Meeting Schedule for Fiscal Year 2024 with the Board of Supervisors' Meetings at the Tavistock offices, 6900 Tavistock Lakes Blvd. Suite 200, Orlando, FL 32827 on the third Tuesday of each month at 3:00 p.m. except for November, December and March, which will be on the second Tuesday of the month, and the Construction Committee Meetings will be held on the second Thursday of each month at 3:30 p.m. at the Tavistock offices, 6900 Tavistock Lakes Blvd. Suite 200, Orlando, FL 32827 except for December and March, which will be on the first Tuesday of the month.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Prequalified Contractors Extension

Mr. Newton stated as a matter of practice, the District prequalifies general contractors to construct infrastructure projects for the District. The District last did this in August of 2021. Those prequalifications are good for two years with an optional two-year extension. The recommendation of the Construction Committee is that the Board extends the prequalification for a period of one-year and address it again next year.

On motion by Mr. Czapka, seconded by Ms. Salvo, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Boggy Creek Improvement District accepted the Construction Committees recommendation to extend the pregualified Contractors for one year.

SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Extending Annual Renewal for State Road 417 (Central Florida Greeneway) & Lake Nona Boulevard Interchange Landscape and Irrigation Maintenance Services Agreement with Cepra

Ms. Walden stated when the District goes out to bid, the District gets three years of pricing. However, the agreement is only for a one-year term and then every year District staff evaluates how the vendor is doing and if the District wants to extend the agreement for an additional year. After speaking to the team, Cepra is doing well, and District staff is asking for the Board to extend the agreement for one additional year.

On motion by Ms. Salvo, seconded by Mr. Czapka, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Boggy Creek Improvement District approved Extending the Annual Renewal for State Road 417 (Central Florida Greeneway) & Lake Nona Boulevard Interchange Landscape and Irrigation Maintenance Services Agreement with Cepra.

SEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Extending Annual Renewal for Lake Nona Boulevard South and Roadways Landscape and Irrigation Maintenance Services Agreement with Cepra

Ms. Walden stated that Cepra also services this area. Since they are doing well, District staff is asking for the Board to extend the agreement for one additional year.

On motion by Ms. Salvo, seconded by Mr. Czapka, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Boggy Creek Improvement District approved Extending the Annual Renewal for Lake Nona Boulevard South and Roadways Landscape and Irrigation Maintenance Services Agreement with Cepra.

EIGHTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Ratification of Disclosure
Dissemination Agent Agreement

Ms. Mackie stated in front of the Board is the Dissemination Agent Agreement between the District and PFM Group Consulting LLC. The Board may recall in connection with the most recent Bond closing and all other Bond issuances of the District, the District is obligated under the District's Continuing Disclosure Agreement to make certain disclosures with respect to both District information and Developer information in connection with the project funded by the Bonds. PFM historically has served as the District's dissemination agent for the purpose of posting the disclosures to the EMMA website, and there is no change in the fee from prior agreements. This agreement sets forth the terms and obligations to provide those services with respect to the Series 2023 Bonds.

On motion by Mr. Czapka, seconded by Ms. Salvo, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Boggy Creek Improvement District ratified the Disclosure Dissemination Agent Agreement.

NINTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of District Management Fee Increase Letter for Fiscal Year 2024

Ms. Walden stated the District Manager's firm is asking for an increase of \$2,500.00 which would put the fee at \$42,500.00 for the year. She noted that the last time there was a fee increase was over two years ago. Dr. Levey added that Tavistock has signed off on this as well.

On motion by Ms. Salvo, seconded by Mr. Czapka, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Boggy Creek Improvement District approved the District Management Fee Increase for Fiscal Year 2024.

On motion by Mr. Czapka, seconded by Ms. Salvo, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Boggy Creek Improvement District approved Resolution 2023-11, Adopting an Assessment Roll for Fiscal Year 2024 Budget and Certifying Special Assessments for Collection.

TWELFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Ratification of Operation and Maintenance Expenditures Paid in July 2023 in an amount totaling \$107,287.74

Dr. Levey noted that these expenditures have been approved and need to be ratified by the Board.

On motion by Ms. Salvo, seconded by Mr. Czapka, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Boggy Creek Improvement District ratified the Operation and Maintenance Expenditures Paid in July 2023 in an amount totaling \$107,287.74.

THIRTEENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Ratification of Requisition No. 411 – 416 Paid in July 2023 in an amount totaling \$25,895.42

The Board reviewed Requisition No. 411 – 416. Dr. Levey noted these have been approved and need to be ratified.

District Engineer -

Mr. Newton stated the roundabout at Veteran's Way and Laureate Blvd. is deemed not feasible, so the District needs to go back to the signal. He stated District staff would like to go straight to Florida Industrial Electric. Dr. Levey asked if there were other proposers. Dr. Newton noted when this first went out to bid there were no proposers, but he was able to get Florida Industrial Electric to provide a proposal. Mr. Newton stated he

reached out to Florida Industrial Electric a few weeks ago to confirm the pricing and the quote has gone up about 5%, so it's just over \$1,000,000.00. The VA has committed to up to \$600,000.00 or 50%, whichever is less, so the District is still covered for half of that cost. Mr. Newton stated the District would get it executed with the Chair and then bring it back for Board ratification.

On motion by Mr. Czapka, seconded by Ms. Salvo, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Boggy Creek Improvement District authorized the District Engineer to move forward with a contract with Florida Industrial Electric for the signal.
